SEVENTH DAY NOVENA PRAYER

Some of the most beautiful pages of the Gospel show us our Lord restoring sight to the blind, hearing to the deaf, and speech to the mute and free use of the limbs of the paralysed. This is the

miraculous virtue from Jesus. And Jesus went out and healed; and from his goodness and teaching, all infirmities and even the most stubborn diseases yielded. St Anne had received some of the healing powers of her Divine Grandson. Whenever an invalid turns to her, he can be sure that he may hope for her wonder-working intervention. And so, the sick have absolute confidence in her. They turn to her as all invalids cried out in other days to Jesus. The cures we owe to St Anne are, like those of Jesus, destined far more for the conversion and sanctification of souls than for the restoration of human bodies. And so, if we implore our cure through St Anne's intercession, let us above all expect from her the health of our poor souls.
